# MD TEN PIN COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

## ELIGIBILITY

1. The Maryland Ten Pin Council Scholarship Tournament is open to all **Youth High School students who will be graduating at the end of the 2015 and 2016 school year** and are a certified members of one of the following Local Maryland USBC Associations:

Lower Eastern Shore USBC Association  
Western Maryland USBC Association  
Antietam USBC Youth  
Cecil Harford USBC Youth  
Central Maryland USBC Youth  
Western Chesapeake Bay USBC Youth

2. All entrants **MUST** be a current member of a 2014-2015 MDUSBC Youth league to be permitted to enter this competition. **(see average requirement)**
3. All entrants must have at least 21 games in a certified 2013 – 2014 MDUSBC youth fall, winter or summer league.
4. Entrants may enter only once.
5. Tournament deadline is May 4, 2015. Walk-in entrants will not be allowed.
6. No entries will be accepted without full payment of fees and without all requested information completed. No entry fees will be refunded.

## AVERAGE REQUIREMENT

7. Entrant shall use their highest certified USBC average established in any USBC youth certified league from the 2013-2014 season for 21 games or more **OR** their highest averages from a current 2014-2015 season for 12 games or more as of April 4, 2015. **A copy of the league standing sheet as of April 4 must accompany the entry form.** It is the bowler's responsibility to provide league sheets.
8. If entrant does not have 12 or more games in a MDUSBC Youth league in the 2014-15 season they must bowl scratch.

## FORMAT

9. This tournament is scratch and handicap. All entrants will bowl six (6) games across twelve (12) lanes. There will be separate divisions for boys and girls. Total pin fall will determine the winners.
10. Scholarships will be awarded in the following order for boy and girl divisions. 1<sup>st</sup> place handicap and scratch \$750.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> place handicap and scratch \$500.00. Bowlers may win only one prize per lifetime. Scratch will take precedence. Scholarships will be deposited into USBC SMART Account # 11225.

11. Scheduling will be accomplished on a first come, first served basis.
12. All entrants must check in at least 30 minutes prior to competition. All entrants must present current Maryland USBC Youth membership card at check in.
13. Tardy entrants will be permitted to bowl but will receive a zero for all frames missed.
14. No participant will be permitted to use tobacco products, illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, foul language, or play game machines during competition. No portable radios, CD's or electronic devices will be allowed. Use of cell phones during competition will not be allowed.
15. Appropriate attire is required at the discretion of the tournament director. All participants will be required to wear suitable attire. No hats, inappropriate t-shirts, midriff shirts, tank tops or very short pants will be allowed.
16. One lane courtesy will be observed. There will be no extra loud noise, inappropriate gestures or running-out shots.
17. Entrants must remain in the bowling circle and be ready to bowl when it is their turn or a zero frame may be given. Only participants and bowling officials shall be permitted in the bowling circle during competition.
18. Tournament Director shall decide any questions not covered by these rules. Any appeal or protest must be made in accordance with USBC rules within 48 hours of competition.
19. USBC Rules will prevail when not specifically covered in the above.
