YOUTH 600 SCRATCH SCHOLARSHIP RULES

- 1. The Maryland State United States Bowling Congress 600 Series Mixed Scratch Scholarship Tournament is open to all youth bowlers who are USBC certified members.
- 2. All eligible entrants competing in a current 2015-2016 USBC certified league with a 12 game minimum by May 16, 2016 will be permitted to enter this competition.
- 3. A 600 series verified by the league secretary, coach or association secretary is required to have been bowled in any year by May 16, 2016.
- 4. Entrants may enter only once.
- 5. A maximum of five entrants shall be scheduled on each pair of lanes.
- 6. Preregistration date is May 16, 2016. Walk-in entrants will be allowed no later than 30 minutes prior to competition providing lanes are available.
- No entries will be accepted without full payment of fees and without all requested information completed. No entry fees will be refunded.
- This tournament is scratch only. All entrants will bowl five
 (5) games across ten (10) lanes. The 4 male and 4 female entrants who score the highest scratch series will advance to the stepladder finals and will receive scholarships.
- 9. Pattern will be USBC White #3.
- 10. This Tournament will be a Junior Gold Qualifier. There must be a minimum of four (4) entrants who will pay the entry fee of \$50.00. The ratio for advancement to the National Competition will be 1:4. Fees will be returned if there are not enough participants. The 2016 Junior Gold Championships will be held July 16-23 in Indianapolis, IN. All qualifiers must be Junior Gold Members prior to competition.
- 11. Scheduling will be accomplished on a first come, first served basis.
- 12. All entrants must check in at least 30 minutes prior to competition. All entrants must present current USBC Youth membership card at check in. Preregistered tardy entrants will be permitted to bowl but will receive a zero for all frames missed.
- 12. A one game roll off will break a tie for stepladder finalists only. Should a tie still exist, an additional 9th and 10th frame roll off will be used to break the tie.

- 13. Awards will be based on a ratio of at least 1:7 (seven) for males and at least 1:7 (seven) for females with a guarantee of a minimum of four (4) places for males and four (4) places for females. Scholarships will be deposited into USBC SMART Account # 8780. An additional \$400 will be donated to the Scholarship Awards from the Mallette Scholarship Fund. The Tournament Director reserves the right to rule on the final disbursements of the scholarship money and to correct any errors in scores before prizes are awarded.
- 14. No participant will be permitted to use tobacco products, illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, foul language, or play game machines during competition. No portable radios, CD's or electronic devices of any kind will be allowed. Use of cell phones for any reason during competition will not be allowed.
- 15. Appropriate attire is required at the discretion of the tournament director. All participants will be required to wear suitable attire. No hats, inappropriate t-shirts, midriff shirts, tank tops or very short pants will be allowed.
- 16. One lane courtesy will be observed. There will be no extra loud noise, inappropriate gestures or running-out shots.
- Entrants must remain in the bowling circle and be ready to bowl when it is their turn or a zero frame may be given. Only participants and bowling officials shall be permitted in the bowling circle during competition.
- Tournament Director shall decide any questions not covered by these rules. Any appeal or protest must be made in accordance with USBC rules within 48 hours of competition.
- 19. USBC Rules will prevail when not specifically covered in the above.
