#### MARYLAND TEN PIN COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- The Maryland Ten Pin Council Scholarship Tournament is open to all Youth High School students, 14 years or older as of the tournament date and are a certified member of one of the following Local Maryland USBC Associations for the 2021-2022 season:
  - Cecil Harford USBC Association
  - Greater Baltimore USBC Association
  - Eastern Shore USBC Association
  - Mid-Maryland USBC Association
  - Western Maryland USBC Association
- 2. All entrants must have at least 12 games in a certified 2021-2022 MDUSBC league as of November 13, 2021.
- 3. Pre-entry Tournament deadline is November 15, 2021. Walk-in entrants will be allowed only if lanes are available.
- 4. No entries will be accepted without full payment of fees and without all requested information completed. No entry fees will be refunded.

#### AVERAGE REQUIREMENT

5. Entrant shall use their highest certified USBC average established in any USBC youth certified league from the 2021-2022 season for 12 games or more. A copy of the league standing sheet as of November 13, 2021 must accompany the entry form. It is the bowler's responsibility to provide league sheets.

#### **FORMAT**

- 6. This tournament is scratch and handicap. All entrants will bowl six (6) games across twelve (12) lanes. There will be four divisions as follows: girls scratch, girls handicap, boys scratch and boys handicap. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
- **7.** Scholarships will be awarded in the following order based on the number of entries for each division. 1st place \$600; 2nd place \$300.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$200; 4<sup>th</sup> place \$100; 5<sup>th</sup> place \$75.
- 8. Bowlers may only win one first place prize for a lifetime. If they place lower than first, they will be allowed to bowl the following year providing they meet the eligibility requirements.

- Bowlers placing for scholarships in more than one division will receive the highest scholarship available to them. Scratch will take precedence. Scholarships will be deposited into USBC SMART Account # 11225.
- Scheduling will be accomplished on a first come, first served basis.
- 11. All entrants must check in at least 30 minutes prior to competition. All entrants must present current Maryland USBC Youth membership card at check in.
- 12. Tardy entrants will be permitted to bowl, if room permits, but will receive a zero for all frames missed.
- 13. No participant will be permitted to use tobacco products, illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, foul language, or play game machines during competition. No portable radios, CD's or electronic devices of any kind will be allowed. Use of cell phones for any reason during competition will not be allowed.
- 14. All participants will be required to wear suitable attire. Appropriate attire will be determined at the discretion of the tournament director. No hats, inappropriate tshirts, midriff shirts or very short or very low cut pants will be allowed.
- 15. One lane courtesy will be observed. There will be no extra loud noise, inappropriate gestures or running-out shots.
- 16. Entrants must remain in the bowling circle and be ready to bowl when it is their turn or a zero frame may be given. Only participants and bowling officials shall be permitted in the bowling circle during competition.
- 17. Tournament Director shall decide any questions not covered by these rules. Any appeal or protest must be made in accordance with USBC rules within 48 hours of competition.
- 18. USBC Rules will prevail when not specifically covered in the above.
